Overview: Our course covers the fundamentals of shipping dangerous goods by air using the IATA regulations. Dangerous Goods training applies to any individual who:

- Loads, unloads, or handles dangerous goods;
- Marks, labels, or otherwise prepares containers or packagings for transportation of dangerous goods by air;
- Prepares Shipper's Declaration for dangerous goods;
- Is responsible for safety of transporting dangerous goods; or
- needs IATA Category 1 training.
